English

- Read the novel – ‘Street child’ by Berlie Doherty
- Answer literal, inference and deductions questions about Street Child and other texts based on Victorian times
- Read non-fiction biographies and information texts about the era
- Write elements of a story set In Victorian times
- Write a newspaper report about a workhouse runaway.
- Write a narrative poem about ‘The Highwayman’

Maths

- Understand Place value, addition and subtraction formal methods and also Perimeter and Area.
- Complete reasoning maths questions using times and divide.
- Develop a better understanding of statistics.

Science

- Investigate living things and their habitats
- Know facts about animals, lifecycles and identify processes in living things
- Ask scientific questions and answer these through research.
- Develop scientific enquiry through investigations.

- Develop drawing techniques in art.
