Topic Titles: Spring A – Natural Disasters : Spring B – World War 1

Aspects to be taught:

- Read novel – ‘I survived’ by Lauren Tarshis and ‘Stay where you are and then leave’ by John Boyne.
- Answer literal, inference and deductions questions about texts based on Natural Disasters and WW1
- Read non-fiction biographies and information texts about the events.
- Write elements of a story set during a natural disaster and an information/explanation text on how WW1 started.

- Investigate properties and changes in materials and then move onto Earth and Space.
- Know facts about reversible and irreversible changes.
- Ask scientific questions about Space and Space travel.
- Develop scientific enquiry through investigations.

- Understand factors, prime numbers, square numbers, cube numbers and statistics.
- Complete reasoning maths questions using timetables and line graphs.
- Develop a better understanding of statistics.

- Develop Spanish to speak about our families, days of the week and hold conversations in Spanish.
- Learn to write songs, considering harmony, structure and texture. Learn to compose.
- Learn about art in religion and the Easter story.
- Learn how to use spreadsheets and databases.
- DT – Cooking and healthy eating and Clay modelling.
- To develop ball handling skills in PE.
- Citizenship – working together and learning about diversity and communities.
