Multiplication tables check (MTC)

Towards the end of the year we will be partaking in the government's multiplication tables check. This is an online assessment which tests the ability of children to recall their multiplication table facts up to 12x12.

There has always been a considerable focus on times tables in Year 4 as confidence in these helps in many other aspects of the Maths curriculum, we will have a weekly practise of the MTC format using TTRS.
