

YEAR 6 CURRICULUM FOCUS

Spring 2023



Topic Title: World War Two & North America

English

In English during this half term, we will be using the text, *Once* by Morris Gleitzman. This will provide the inspiration for writing stories, recounts, and classical poetry. We will use the axis-controlled countries to further inspire the children's writing.

During the second half term, we will begin our topic on the Americas by focussing on North America. We will use the events of 9/11 and the uplifting text of *Wonder* by RJ Palacio as our inspiration for writing. We will create an information text, biography, and story.

Maths

In Maths this term, we will be solving a variety of fluency, reasoning and problem-solving problems based on Place Value, Four Operations, Measurement, Fractions, and Decimals. We will use a variety of strategies using concrete equipment, pictorial representations, and abstract methods.

Science

In Science during this half term, we will be looking at Animals including humans. We will learn about the importance of the circulatory system and how it transports oxygen around our body.

During the second half term, we will be looking at Living Things and their Habitats. We will learn about classification of living things, including microorganisms. They will learn the names and characteristics of the main groups used to classify animals, plants and microorganisms.

Foundation Subjects

In Geography this term, we will be introduced to the key features of the United States of America (USA). We will develop an understanding of the different environments present within the USA: the key physical features, where populations are distributed, and some of the interactions between the human and physical environments focusing on food, farming, and water.

In History this term, we will be looking at World War Two and axis-controlled controlled countries. This will include looking at how these countries changed and the ways in which groups of people were persecuted and protected. This will include looking at anti-Jewish laws and the Kindertransport programme.

In RE this term, we will be investigating Buddhism and looking at various aspects of this religion including its core beliefs and teachings; worship and symbols; four noble truths and various religious stories.

In Computing this term, we will be looking at Networks and Spreadsheets using Purple Mash.

In Design and Technology this term, we will be looking at food and creating our own American-inspired burgers.

In Art this term, we will be looking at Charles Burns and creating our own silhouettes. We will use the Blitz as an inspiration to create our own silhouette art.

In PE this term, we will be developing our skills in Netball, Cricket, and Gymnastics.

In PSHE this term, we will be looking at anti-bullying, financial capability, and economic wellbeing.
