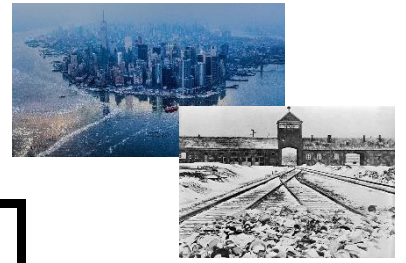


YEAR 6 CURRICULUM FOCUS



Spring 2026

Topic Title: World War Two & North America

English

In English during this half term, we will be using Letters from the Lighthouse by Emma Carroll as our inspiration for our writing. During the second half term, we will be using the text, Once by Morris Gleitzman. This will provide the inspiration for writing stories, biographies, and classical poetry. We will use the axis-controlled countries to further inspire the children's writing.

Maths

In Maths this term, we will be solving a variety of fluency, reasoning and problem-solving problems based on Place Value, Four Operations, Measurement, Fractions, and Decimals. We will use a variety of strategies using concrete equipment, pictorial representations, and abstract methods.

Science

In Science during this half term, we will be looking at Living Things and their Habitats. We will learn about classification of living things, including microorganisms. They will learn the names and characteristics of the main groups used to classify animals, plants and microorganisms. During the second half term, we will be looking at Light. We will investigate how light travels in straight lines; how our eyes work to allow us to see things and how shadows are created.

Foundation Subjects

In Geography this term, we will be introduced to the key features of the United States of America (USA). We will develop an understanding of the different environments present within the USA: the key physical features, where populations are distributed, and some of the interactions between the human and physical environments focusing on food, farming, and water.

In History this term, we will be looking at World War Two and axis-controlled controlled countries. This will include looking at how these countries changed and the ways in which groups of people were persecuted and protected. This will include looking at anti-Jewish laws and the Kindertransport program.

In RE this term, we will be investigating Buddhism and looking at various aspects of this religion including its core beliefs and teachings; worship and symbols; four noble truths and various religious stories.

In Computing this term, we will be creating media and designing our very own webpage.

In Design and Technology this term, we will be looking at food and creating our own meals using a variety of skills.

In Art this term, we will be looking at the techniques associated with creating silhouettes and incorporating these into WWII inspired backgrounds.

In PE this term, we will be developing our skills in Rugby and NFL, as well as continuing with our Healthy Lifestyles focus.

In PHSCE this term, we will be looking at citizenship, anti-bullying, financial capability, and economic wellbeing.
