

Year 2 Summer Term Homework Expectation

The impact of homework activities on learning in school ensure clearer expectations are set so that parents can facilitate the homework more easily, whilst providing greater independence for the children.

Reading

Research shows that the more exposure your child has to reading, the more academically able they will be. We recommend and encourage all children to read or be read to every day.

Children in year 2 are expected to record a minimum of **4 reads** each week for at least **15 minutes**. Reading at home must be recorded in the reading diary with a parent signature.

Reading books will be checked by teachers every Friday.
