

## Year 3 Summer Term Homework Expectation

Outlined below are the homework expectations for this term.

### Reading

Research shows that the more exposure your child has to reading, the more academically able they will be. We recommend and encourage all children to read or be read to every day.

Children in Year 3 are expected to read **4 TIMES A WEEK**. When your child reads at home, please ensure you write in their **READING RECORD**.

When your child has finished their book, please remind them to take a quiz on **ACCELERATED READER** when they get to school. **PLEASE NOTE, QUIZZES ARE NOT ACCESSIBLE AT HOME.**

**Reading Records will be checked by teachers every Friday.**

### Spellings

Your child will have a weekly assignment scheduled on Spelling Shed. Please ensure they complete **THREE GAMES** within this assignment.

**Spelling Shed will also be checked on a Friday.**

### Maths

Each week your child should complete **10 GARAGE SESSIONS** on Times table Rock stars which can be accessed via <https://trockstars.com/>.
